# 4K Program

# Philosophy

Through ongoing collaboration between the Oregon School District, community partners and families, the 4K Ready for Learning program is an all-inclusive learning opportunity. The curriculum and assessments are aligned to the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards, designed for children birth to first grade. The program exposes children to the inter-related developmental domains of social and emotional development, communication, language and early literacy, mathematical thinking and scientific exploration, health and physical development.

### Class Schedule

Classes are held from 8:00-11:15 a.m. or 12:00-3:15 p.m. Monday through Thursday. As part of the Oregon 4K Ready for Learning program, we follow the Oregon School District calendar with a few exceptions.

## Fees/Ages Served

There are no fees associated with this program, as it is fully funded by the Oregon School District. Your child must be 4 on or before September 1st of the year they are enrolling.

# Registration Information

We have both morning and afternoon classes available. Our class size ranges from 17-20 students. Contact the Oregon School District registrar for a 4K registration packet by calling 608-835-4033. 4K registration information will be handed out at the Oregon School District sponsored 4K parent informational nights, these are usually scheduled at the end of January.

# Childcare/Wrap-care Program

# Hours of Operation

Hours of operation are Monday through Friday from 7:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. Parents are able to enroll their children in full-time or part-time day care hours with a minimum of 4 hours per day and 2 days per week.

### Rates/Fees

- Our registration fee is \$150 per child, this is a one time fee if your child attends care continuously. If your child stops and restarts care (example: summer break) you will be required to pay the registration fee to restart care in the fall.
- Childcare fee is \$8.40/hour with a minimum of 4 hour per day and 2 days per week. We do not have a weekly or monthly rate.
- Parents are required to pay the full weekly tuition, based on their contracted schedule, regardless of center opening/ closing.
- Families will be given one week of vacation, based on their contracted schedule, to use towards non-attendance days (sick, vacation, or holidays). It is the families' responsibility to inform our office staff when you intend to use these days. These days do not carry over from one contract year to the next.

### Ages Served

We serve children 3 years old through the beginning of their Kindergarten year.

### Closing Schedule

- Our center will be closed for the following holidays: Labor Day, Thanksgiving day & the Friday after, Christmas Eve & Christmas Day, New Year's Eve & New Year's Day, Good Friday, Memorial Day, Independence Day and 2 preplanned floating holidays.
- Our center will be closed for 2 full days in August for deep cleaning and staff development. We will also close early one night in August to prep for the annual Back-to-School night.
- We follow the Oregon School District (OSD) for delays, early releases, and cancellations due to the weather. You will
  need to listen/watch for OSD decision on the internet, radio or TV, Little Angels will not be listed. We do list weather
  related closing information on our Facebook page.

## Nap Time

Our nap time is roughly between 12:30 and 2:30. We will provide cots/mats and sheets that are washed weekly for each child. Parents provide children with a blanket and small pillow that are sent home at the end of each week for washing. All children that are enrolled in childcare at 12:30 are required to go into the nap room and lay quietly for 30 minutes.

- Children that have not fallen asleep after 30 minutes will be taken back to the childcare room for quiet play.
- Families can request that their child be awakened at any time after the initial 30 minutes. All sleeping children will be awakened starting at 2:30.

#### Meals

We will provide breakfast and snacks. Breakfast is completed by 7:45 Lunch is to be provided by parents.

- Breakfast will consist of a grain, fruit, and milk.
- Snacks will consist of 2 of the 4 food groups.
- Parent provided lunches should contain a dairy, a protein, a grain, and a fruit or vegetable.

### Curriculum

This is a Christian based childcare setting therefore, faith based lessons will be included. Our childcare staff teach children through a combination of free-play, book time, and structured learning activities.
